

1st Quarter 2022 Financial Results

Our dividend is \$0.35 per share in 1st Quarter! At the end of first quarter, our net income is projected at \$1.2 Million. With projected assets (not including loans from the Paycheck Protection Program) of \$554.5 Million, up 12.7% year over year, and loan growth at \$62.7 Million or up 15.6% year over year, we hold a strong financial position. We have grown deposits by \$43.2 Million, a year-over-year growth of 9.8%.

I would also like to formally thank all of you who sent in your proxy for the recent Annual Stockholder Meeting. It was so nice to see those of you who made it, too. Of note, the proposed amendments passed.
